By the public sphere we mean first of all a realm of our social life in which something approaching public opinion can be formed and which is accessible to all. According to Habermas, Kant was the first philosophy to give to public sphere "its completed theoretical structure" in a text of political philosophy, entitled "What is Enlightenment?" Hence, concern with the public sphere and the necessary conditions for a genuine democracy can be seen as a central theme of Habermas's work that deserves to be examined.
